
PROPERTY TAXES

Spring Inspection Reminders



The **Ants** come marching one by one - please try to send them on their way!

A mixture of 40% Borax powder and 60% Icing Sugar sprinkled around the perimeter of your unit may help to control the spread of ants.

Aphids

Check your garden plants for aphids as ants are attracted to aphids as a food source.

Planting

Please do not plant in common areas or along hedge lines and trim back shrubs from siding and fences to prevent insects from entering units and to prevent mold or rot issues.

Carports

Remember to keep your carports cleans and tidy.
